



DARC SUNDAY EVENING NET PREAMBLE

(UPDATED 01/01/2017)

"Good evening, this is: <callsign>, my name is <name of net control operator> opening the Dixie Amateur Radio Club Sunday evening net."

"This net is conducted every Sunday evening at 8:00 PM local time for the purpose of handling traffic, making announcements, selling or trading ham related items and to get acquainted with call signs and fellow hams."

"The Dixie Amateur Radio Club meets the third Wednesday of every month, except December, at 7:00 PM in the St. George Community Building located behind the Gayle M. & Mary Aldred Senior Citizens Center, 245 North 200 West, St. George, Utah. Please see our club website (www.dixieham.org) for details about the upcoming meeting and a map to the location. Also listen to this net for further information about the upcoming Club meeting and other Club activities. There is a Volunteer Exam session before each Club meeting in the same location, beginning at 5:30 PM."

"Emergency traffic may be indicated by a triple break, and will be accepted at any time. This is a directed net. Do not transmit unless you are directed to do so by the net control station. You will be placed on the roll by checking in three times in one month and will remain on the roll by checking in at least once each calendar month."

"At the end of each month, members who have not checked in will be removed from the roll and will lose their roll call position. Members who are absent due to sickness, equipment failure, or otherwise unable to check in for long periods of time, may have their roll call placement frozen by contacting a net control operator before they are removed from the list. Frozen call signs will not be called during roll call check-in and may only be frozen for up to 6 months before removal."

"Any station with traffic or news for the net, please check in now."

"Unless otherwise directed by net control, all stations will please remain on frequency until all traffic has been listed and assigned."

"First – do we have any internet protocol check ins? Any ham operator listed on the Sunday evening net roster or any licensed guests calling in via Echolink, please check in now."

[the Net Control Station will acknowledge all who call in via Echolink before moving on to call the roll]

"The following is roll call of those listed on the current Sunday evening net roster....."

[the Net Control Station will call each ham operator listed on the most current Sunday net roster]

"That concludes the roll call. I will now listen for any late or missed roll call check ins on the Utah Hill 145.49 repeater please call now....."

"I will now listen for any late or missed roll call check ins on the Webb Hill 146.64 repeater. Please call now....."

"I will now listen for any late or missed roll call check ins on the Toquerville 145.45 repeater. Please call now....."

"I will now listen for any visitors on the Utah Hill 145.49 repeater. Please call in now....."

"I will now listen for any visitors on the Webb Hill 146.64 repeater. Please call in now....."

"I will now listen for any visitors on the Toquerville 145.45 repeater. Please call in now....."

"This is the last call for check ins on any repeater, from any station, with any further business for the net....."

"At this time the Dixie Amateur Radio Club would like to thank all those who have checked in tonight."
